The 10th Annual Conference of the European Network of Ombudsmen in Higher Education, hosted by the OIA, will be held at the University of Oxford from 11-13 April 2013. It is open to all members of the ENOHE network.

This event presents a unique opportunity to experience two contrasting Colleges at this world-famous institution. The meeting rooms and accommodation are at St Catherine's College, which, as the University's newest college, has modern facilities including en-suite bedrooms. The Gala Dinner on 12 April is to be held in the dining hall at Oriel College, one of the University's oldest Colleges (founded in 1326).

The “early bird” cost of the Conference is £450 (for bookings before 31 December 2012). This cost is all-inclusive and covers the following:
