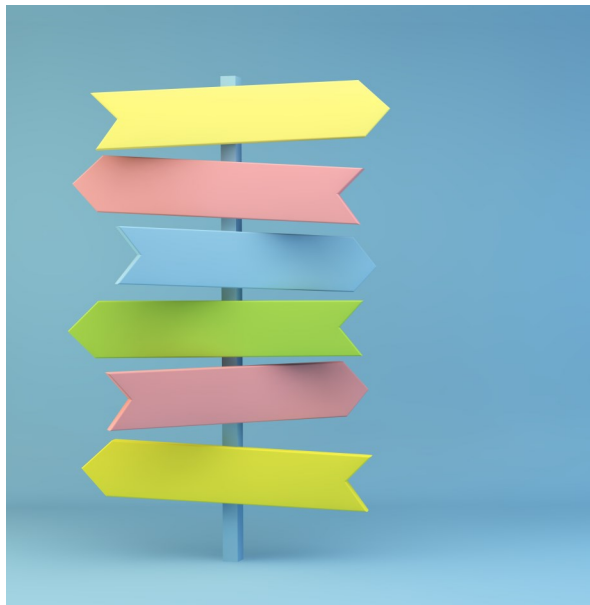

Complaint list enhancement on MyOIA

You can now view “Completion of Procedures Letter date” and “complaint category” information in the complaint list on MyOIA. The “COP Letter date” is visible for both open and closed complaints, and the “complaint category” is displayed only when a complaint has been closed.

The information in these fields is used for OIA reporting purposes and is included in our [Annual Statements](#), so please check our data against your own records regularly. If you have any questions about the information on MyOIA, please contact the case-handler.
