

Prize Draw - Terms and Conditions

Introduction

By completing this survey and indicating that you would like to participate in the prize draw, you are agreeing to these terms and conditions. The prize draw is being run by The Office of the Independent Adjudicator for Higher Education.

Eligibility to Enter

The prize draw is open to entrants who are aged 16 years of age or older and who are currently studying any form of further education within Wales. The Office of the Independent Adjudicator for Higher Education employees and associates are excluded from the draw.

Only entries that include a valid email address for a student at a further education provider in Wales will be eligible for entry to the prize draw.

By entering the prize draw, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and that you are eligible to receive any prizes that may be awarded to you.

Entrants aged 16 or 17 must provide the name and contact details of a parent or legal guardian. By submitting an entry, the parent or legal guardian confirms that they consent to the entrant taking part in the survey and entering the prize draw. We reserve the right to verify this consent and to disqualify any entry where consent cannot be obtained or verified.

There is a limit of one entry per person, and the prize draw is completely free to enter.

The Prize

The total winning prize will be £100, made up of four £25 gift vouchers. The four winners will be selected at random from all of the entries.

The use of specific brands as prizes by The Office of the Independent Adjudicator for Higher Education does not imply any affiliation with or endorsement of such brands.

The prize is non-transferable and non-exchangeable, and no cash alternatives will be provided.

We reserve the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value if circumstances beyond our control require doing so.

The Office of the Independent Adjudicator for Higher Education's decision on any aspect of the competition is final and binding, and no correspondence will be entered into about it.

Winner Announcement

The four winners will be chosen at random and notified via the email address they provided from 22 July 2026.

The Office of the Independent Adjudicator for Higher Education will make two attempts to contact the winner via email.

If the winner does not respond to the emails informing them of their win within 14 days of the second email, they forfeit their right to the prize, and The Office of the Independent Adjudicator for Higher Education reserves the right to select and notify a new winner.

Delivery of the Prize

The winner will allow 14 days for the prize to be delivered via the email they registered with on the survey. This must be a current official student email address of a student in further education in Wales.

Data Protection and Publicity

You agree that any personal information that you provide when entering the competition will be used by The Office of the Independent Adjudicator for Higher Education for the purposes of administering the prize draw. We will only keep personal information that identifies you as an individual for 6 weeks after the closing date.
